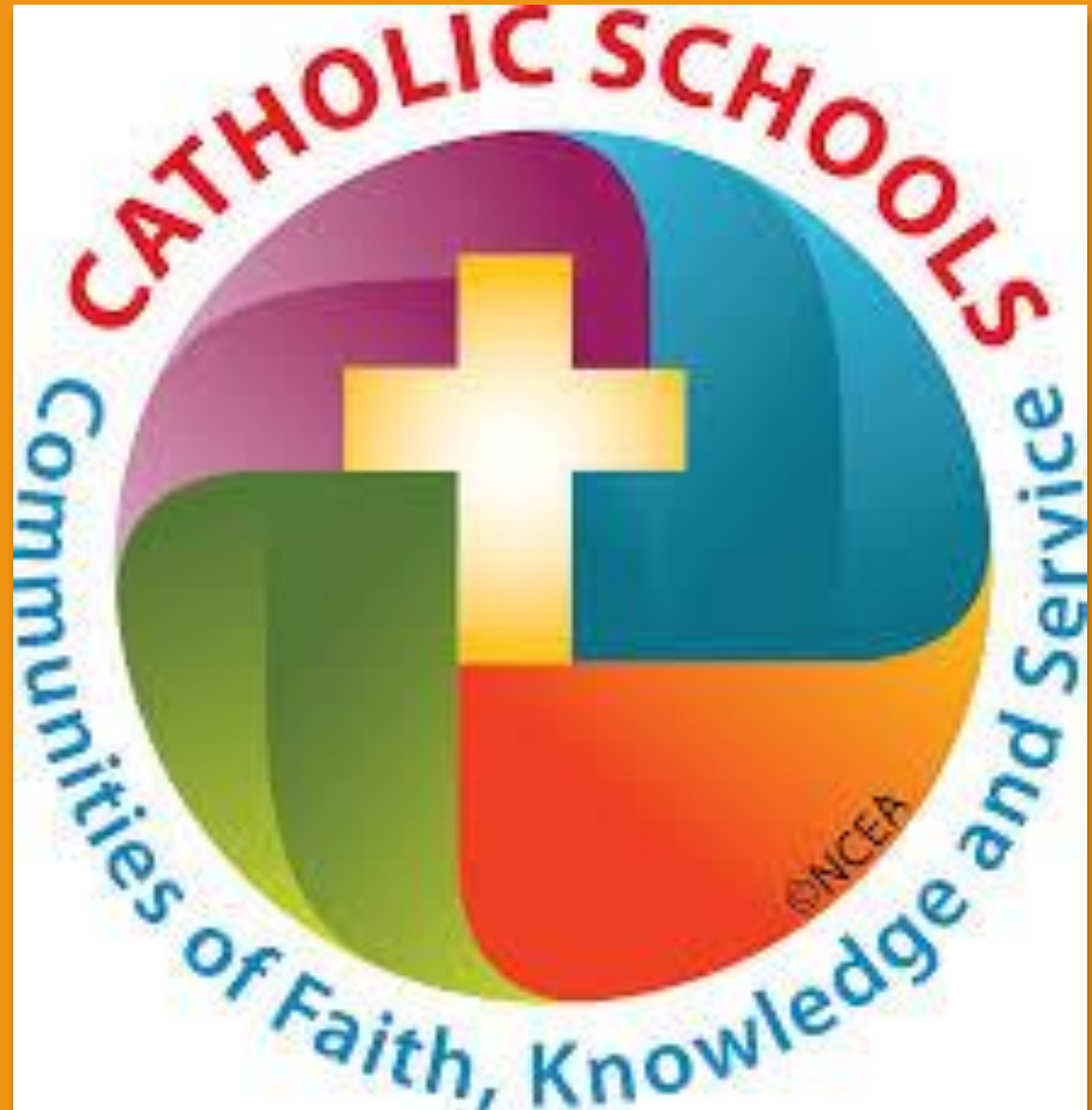

What have we achieved since our last assembly?

- **Renewal of the PPC** with the addition of four new members, three women and two men.
- The addition of several new readers and ministers of the Eucharist.
- The monthly **hospitality** coffee morning has widely been welcomed.
- **Improved communications**, notably the website and Church TV about which there has been quite a lot of positive comment
- The **Alpha Course** was a successful initiative in faith formation and there will be follow-up.
- **Living the Joy of the Gospel** has allowed us to have these initiatives. At the same time, it has contributed to a somewhat improved financial situation although serious problems remain.
- **EVALUATION?** Satisfactory, Very Good? Issues remaining to be addressed?



Pastoral Challenges

- **Reduced clergy** - down from 4 priests to 2 with the additional loss of Sr Margaret Mortell who played an important pastoral role particularly with various groups in the parish.
- What are the issues arising from this situation? How do we address them?
- The mass schedule - questions arising for the development of lay ministry
- **The youth/family question.** The need for a pastoral response.
- **The World Meeting of Families 2018** - how do we respond to this and participate appropriately?

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Who is responsible for Safeguarding ?

- Parish clergy
- Parish Pastoral Council
- Parish Safeguarding Representative's
- Leaders of all the different parish ministries
- Everyone

All must work together to ensure that children and vulnerable adults are cherished and safe from abuse.



What is safeguarding?

- the process of protecting children & vulnerable adults from abuse and neglect
 - preventing impairment of their health and development
 - ensuring that they experience safe and effective care that enables them to have optimum life chances
- Safeguarding Means...
- *Creating safe environments for children & vulnerable adults and*
 - *those who work with them.*



Best practice

- Training for all volunteers
 - Garda vetting of all volunteers in public ministry
 - Code of conduct for adults
 - Code of conduct for children
- Written parental consent for children involved in ministry
- Always minister in an open and transparent manner
- Reporting all concerns, suspicions or allegations of abuse of children/vulnerable adults immediately
